- *Joe's Crab Shack Graphics*, for Joe's Crab Shack, 444 N Shoreline Blvd, Corpus Christi, TX. I was commissioned to re-paint all of the exterior graphics and hang new vinyl signs on their bathroom doors. I hand painted 'I Heart Crabs' in pictographs, 'Eat at Joe's' and Joe's Crab Shack." The location for each of the graphics were about 30ft up on their exterior walls and used a 42 ft personnel boom lift to reach them. I copied the damaged vinyl lettering on the bathroom doors, re-printed and installed them after cleaning the old lettering off.

*-I am the Way*, (clean), First United Methodist Church Corpus Christi, 900 S Shoreline Blvd Corpus Christi TX. Cleaned and resealed *I Am The Way* a 32 ft bronze sculpture of Jesus in front of the UMCCC. used a 42 ft personnel boom lift to reach the top of the sculpture.
